Turrumurra High School approached School Bytes Learning Pty Ltd at the end of Term 3 2016 to provision their school administration software package consisting of the sport selection and student finance modules. This was done to streamline our current processes, both in staff time and cost.

The School Bytes package has made an enormous difference to our Statement of Account process. Already, the Term 4 payments 2016 were increased from the previous year. We're anticipating a significant increase in payments of contributions over a full year. School Bytes also enables us to highlight specific invoices such as elective subject fees and excursions.

As parents are individually emailed, we will be able to send Statements of Account twice each term and will soon be able to filter to send a statement to the 'other' parent separately. This program has also streamlined our excursion process as the invoice and consent form can be sent to parents separate to the Statement of Account.

Most importantly, School Bytes promotes payment to the Parent Online Payment (POP) process, complying with the security issues of processing credit card payments.

Our Sports administrator used the sports package for the first time this year. It allowed students to enter their sport preferences on-line. She was delighted at the ease of the program and that it saved her days of work.

Each term, our school will save at least \$1,000 postage. That alone will cover half the cost of both the finance and the sport packages. There will be considerable saving in paper and printing costs. The immeasurable saving is in staff time. Processes that once took several days and required "all hands on deck" have been streamlined enormously.

School Bytes has provided a user-friendly, DoE-compliant, time-saving, parent-friendly package. I would highly endorse it to any school and would recommend it as an integral part in meeting the needs of their school community.
